

TREMEC Stick Shift Shootout & Racer Appreciation Party Announced

Do you think your manually shifted Ford-powered street machine is one of the quickest in the country? Well, you won't want to miss this! Long-time NMRA supporter, TREMEC has announced that they will host the 5th annual Stick Shift Shootout as part of this year's Nitto Tire NMRA Spring Break Shootout— March 2-5, 2017, in Bradenton, Florida!

The rules are simple: Street-type manual transmissions only. May include race-oriented modifications such as 'face-plated' or 'pro-shifted' gears. Must be hand operated via a single shift handle. Transmissions with multiple levers or air/electronic/hydraulic actuation not permitted. To be eligible, each competitor must declare that he/she is participating in the Stick Shift Shootout by adding their name to the official sign-up list at True Street Tech.

The staging lanes at Bradenton Motorsports Park will be bursting at the seams as over 120 entrants will battle for top QA1 True Street honors, with the fastest 8 stick cars receiving a special shootout plaque to recognize their prowess. From there things will heat-up as the quickest four manual-equipped vehicles will have an all-out slugfest with a 'winner takes all' heads-up finale! The winner will go home with a brand new TREMEC transmission of choice!

Following Saturday's True Street competition, TREMEC will host a Racer Appreciation Party that will take place before the Aerospace Components winners circle awards ceremony on Saturday, March 4th. Open to all True Street racers, along with their families and crew, the gathering will feature plenty hot pizza, cold beer and sodas, and good cheer for all!
