

## TREMEC® Stick Shift Shootout

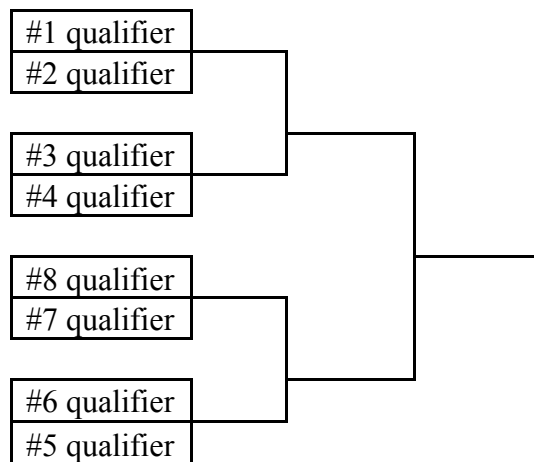

**RULES:** The rules are simple: Street-type manual transmissions only. May include race-oriented modifications such as 'face-plated' or 'pro-shifted' gears. Must be hand operated via a single shift handle. Transmissions with multiple levers or air/electronic/hydraulic actuation not permitted.

**HOW IT WORKS:** The staging lanes at each event will be bursting at the seams as over 150 entrants battle for top True Street honors. The fastest 8 stick cars will receive special shootout plaques, TREMEC jackets, and an invitation to participate in an all-out slugfest with a high-value heads-up finale!

Here's how the Stick Shift Shootout works:

1. True Street average from Saturday True Street eliminations becomes dial in to establish handicapped start in Stick Shift Shootout
2. Handicapped start based on established dial in, no breakout, first to finish wins
3. All applicable True Street and performance rules & regulations apply
4. Use of match race style ladder:
