Ace Racing Spring Break Shootout class is a heads-up Quick 16 format race that will take place on Sunday of the event. The Spring Break Shootout race will be open to the quickest 16 cars that run in QA1 True Street on Saturday. To be eligible for the Spring Break Shootout class, competitors must meet True Street rules, compete in the True Street class on Saturday, and make **all three** True Street passes. The 16 competitors who have the fastest 3-pass averages will be placed on a sportsman ladder and will race heads-up on a 4/10 pro tree.
